TOP OF THE MOURNE TRIATHLON

Top of the Mourne Triathlon is proudly part of the prestigious Triathlon Ireland National Series. This race attracts nearly 400 athletes from Ireland and beyond, showcasing the beauty of Rostrevor and the Mournes. The race starts at 10:30 am with a swim in Carlingford Lough, followed by a cycling journey through the Mournes, and concluding with a run in Kilbroney Park. The first cyclists are expected to return to Rostrevor around 12 noon. For safety, a traffic management company will enforce a single lane closure, Rostrevor-bound from the Newtown Road junction past the church towards the roundabout. Traffic from Rostrevor towards Hilltown will remain unaffected.
